State Revolving Fund Awards

The Department of Environmental Protection approved several projects for the Town. The first two will be eligible under the 2018 Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. The first is a Water Treatment Plant Upgrade for \$9,086,750 and the second project is the Water Main Replacement Project for \$2,000,000. The other two projects will be funded through the Clean Water State Revolving Fund. The first project is the Wastewater Treatment Facility and Pump Station Upgrades for \$7,239,000. The second is the funding for Sewer Contract 37 and 38 in the amount of \$25,661,428. These loans will be funded at 2%. The Treasurer and the Lieutenant Governor will be coming out for a press event for these awards on February 15th at 2:30PM in the Buck Auditorium.

Green Communities Meeting

Neal Duffy from DOER and Beverly Woods are meeting with this office on February 16th to discuss the opportunity of using DLTA grant funds and Municipal Energy Technical Assistances (META) Grant funds to help facilitate our transfer to a green community through energy efficiency programs.

Food Pantry

This office is meeting with Katherine Adams and the Boston Food Bank to discuss potential opportunities. The Food pantry continues to look for space.

Yankee Doodle Bike Path

This office met with the Superintendent, VHB, Ellen Rawlings, Engineering and Left Field to discuss integrating the bike path into the high school site plan. A final conceptual plan will be sent to the Building Committee and the School Committee. VHB will compose the DCR grant application to pay for a portion of this work up to \$100,000.
