

Bulk Item and White Good Collection

Call Waste Management to schedule collection 1-800-972-4545
Items should not be put out until after 4 pm on the day before collection.

Bulk items: (No fees at this time) Bulk items can safely be disposed as trash but are too large to fit in the trash cart. A limit of 4 items will be picked up each week. Examples include a couch, a table and chair set, a mattress and box spring set.

Appliances with Freon (for example: refrigerators or air conditioners)	\$25
Appliances without Freon	\$15
Large Metal items (for example: large microwave ovens, exercise equipment, lawn mowers, grills, snow blowers, wood stoves, radiators)	\$15
TVs, Computers: Measure screen - up to 24" on the diagonal Computers include keyboard and CPU	\$15
TVs, Computers: Measure screen - over 24" on the diagonal Computers include keyboard and CPU	\$25
Small Consumer Electronics (for example: VCR, DVD player)	\$5
Tires Without Rims	\$5
Tires On the Rim	\$15
Propane or Helium tanks – 10 lbs. or smaller MUST be EMPTY	\$5
Propane or Helium tanks – larger than 10 lbs. MUST be EMPTY	\$10
Toilets, Sinks, and Doors (excluding patio doors)	\$20
4 rolls of carpeting cut into strips no wider than 4 feet, rolled and tied.	\$5

Items Not Collected by Waste Management

Construction and Demolition Waste (C&D): Disposal is home owner's responsibility. Examples include: bathtubs, showers, vanities, windows, patio doors, wall mounted cabinets/counters, plywood, sheetrock, lumber. Contact a junk removal service or arrange for a private dumpster.

Fluorescent bulbs –Mercury Recovery: Bring residential fluorescent bulbs to O'Connor Hardware. Mercury thermometers, thermostats, switches and button cell batteries can go to the Board of Health, Room G-03 in Town Hall. Commercial bulbs must be disposed of through private contractor in accordance with legal requirements.

Prescription Drug Take Back: The Billerica Police Department has a drop-off Kiosk for all medications in pill, capsule or tablet form. Place in a sealed plastic bag. No liquids or sharps.

Sharps Disposal: Bring to Board of Health, Room G-03 in Town Hall. Use red sharps container or heavy weight puncture proof plastic container, secured with duct tape.

Propane Tanks: O'Connor Hardware takes large tanks (fees apply) or see Waste Management chart above.

Rechargeable Batteries: Drop off at DPW Administration, Room G-11 in Town Hall. Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium-ion (Li-Ion), Nickel-Zinc (Ni-Zn), and small sealed lead acid batteries.
