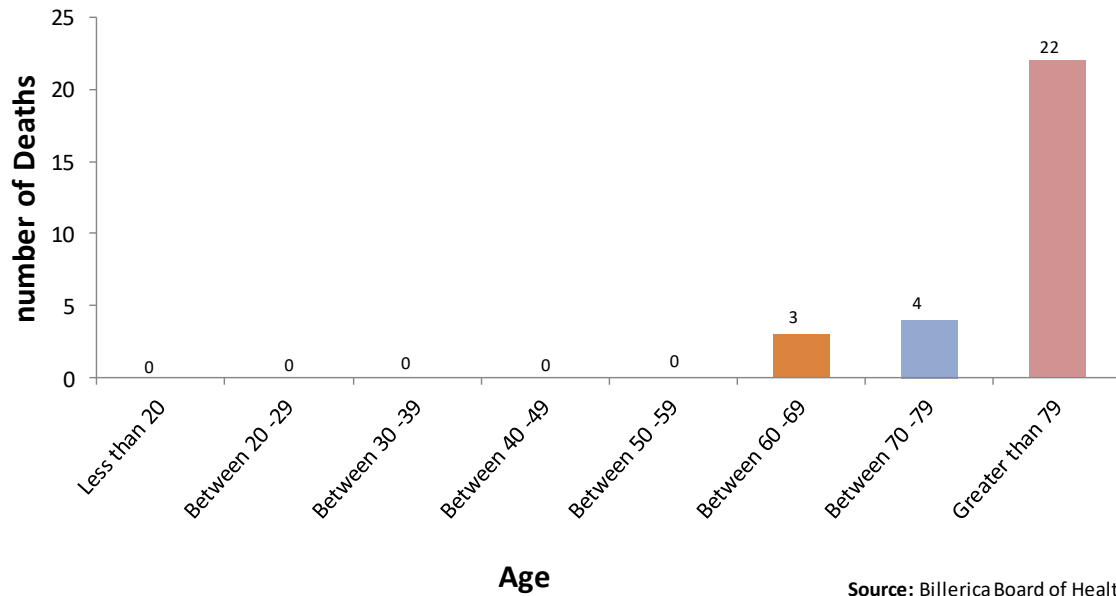

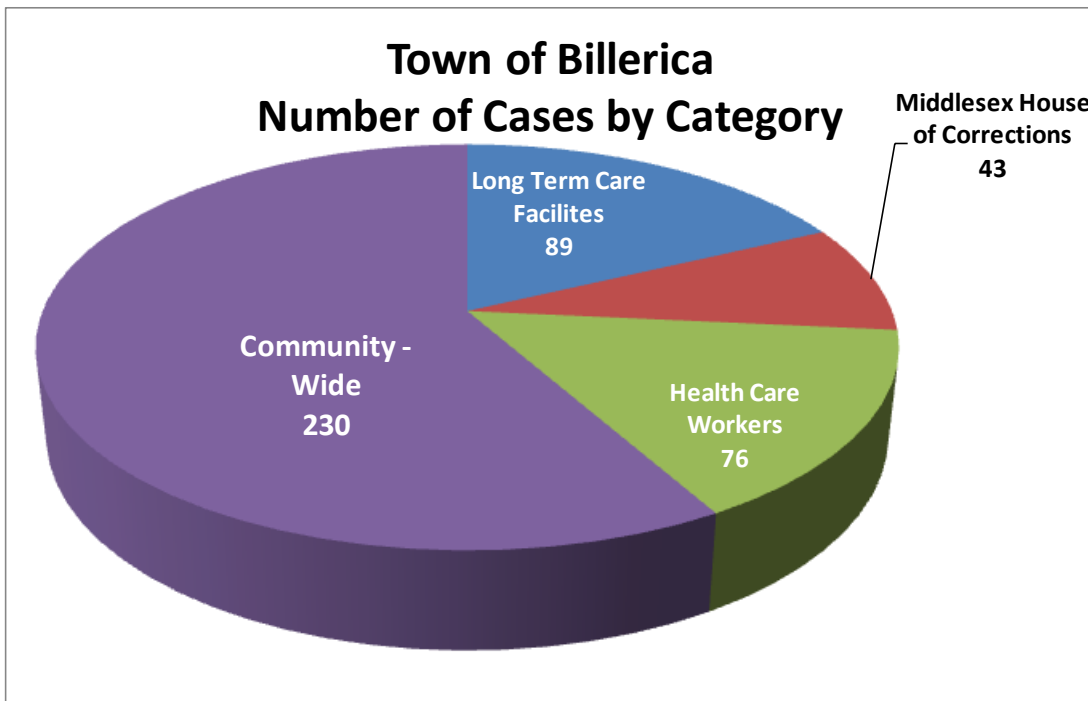

Town of Billerica COVID-19 Deaths by Age

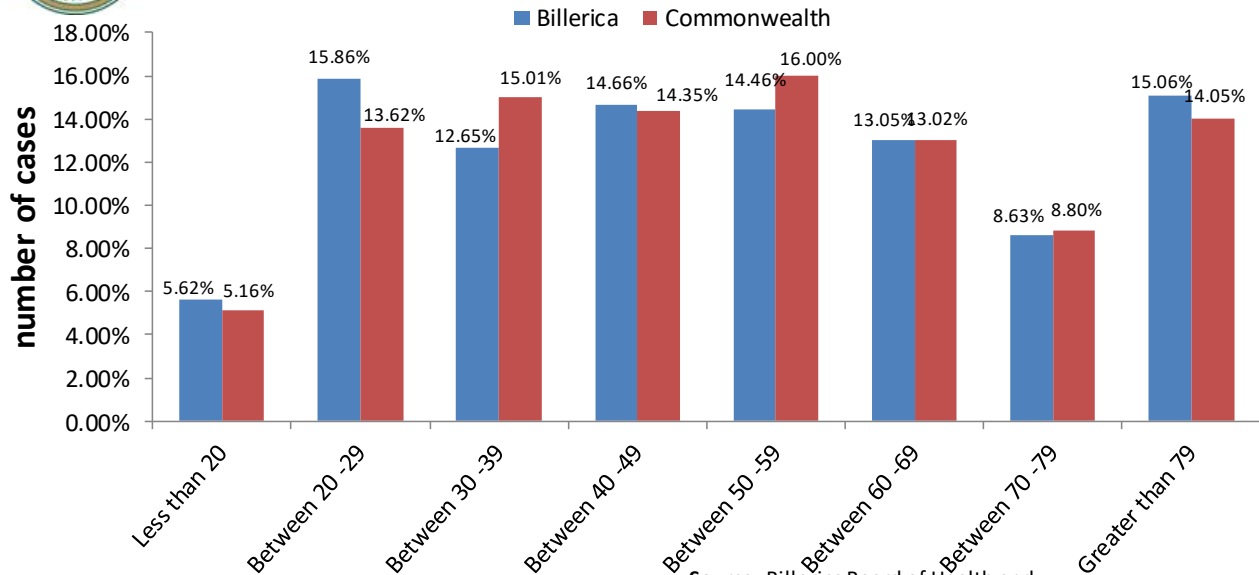
